



MATERIALS

Aunt Lydia® Classic™ Crochet Thread size 10 (350 yds/320 m)

Contrast A Soft Mauve (1040) **1 ball**

Contrast B Aqua (0450) **1 ball**

Contrast C Silver (0435) **1 ball**

Aunt Lydia® Metallic™ Crochet Thread size 10 (100 yds/91.4 m)

Contrast D White/Silver (0001S) **1 ball**

Size U.S. 7 (1.5 mm) Susan Bates® Steelite® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Yarn needle.

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Ch = Chain(s)

Dc = Double crochet

Hdc = Half double crochet

Picot = Ch 3. Sl st in 3rd ch from hook

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Rounds

Sc = Single crochet

Sc3tog = Draw up a loop in each of next 3 sc. Yoh and draw through all 4 loops on hook

Sl st = Slip stitch

Sp(s) = Space(s)

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tr = Treble crochet

Yoh = Yarn over hook

MEASUREMENT

Approx 6" [15 cm] diameter.

GAUGE

36 sc and 40 rows = 4" [10 cm]

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes

- Doily is worked in joined rnds with right side always facing.
- Doily can be worked in any of 3 different versions. Versions differ only in the thread color used for each round.
- Ch 3 at beg of rnds counts as dc.

- To change color, work to last 2 loops on hook and draw new color through last 2 loops, then proceed in new color.

Versions 1 (2-3)

Change colors in the following sequence:

1st rnd: D

2nd rnd: A (C-B)

3rd rnd: D

4th rnd: C (A-C)

5th to 7th rnds: A (C-B)

8th rnd: B (A-C)

9th rnd: A (C-B)

10th rnd: D

11th to 15th rnds: C (B-A)

DOILY

See Diagram on page 3.

With D, ch 4. Join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

1st rnd: Ch 1. 12 sc in ring. Join appropriate color with sl st in first sc. 12 sc. **Do not** fasten off D.

2nd rnd: With appropriate color, ch 1. 2 sc in each sc around. Join D with sl st in first sc. Break color of 2nd rnd. 24 sc.

3rd rnd: With D, ch 4 (counts as dc and ch 1). 1 dc in next sc. *Ch 1. 1 dc in next sc. Rep from * around. Ch 1. Join with sl st in 3rd ch of ch-4. 24 dc and 24 ch-1 sps. Fasten off D.

4th rnd: Join appropriate color with sl st in any ch-1 sp. Ch 3. 1 dc in same sp as sl st. 2 dc in each ch-1 sp around. Join with sl st in top of ch-3. 48 dc. Fasten off.

5th rnd: Join appropriate color in any dc. Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. 2 sc in next dc. *1 sc in next dc. 2 sc in next dc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st in first sc. 72 sc.

6th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. *Ch 9. Skip next 11 sc. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * to last 11 sc. Ch 9. Skip last 11 sc. Join with sl st in first sc. 6 sc and 6 ch-9 sps.

7th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. (5 dc. Ch 2. 5 dc) in next ch-9 sp. *1 sc in next sc. (5 dc. Ch 2. 5 dc) in next ch-9 sp. Rep from * around. Join with sl st in first sc. 6 sc and 6 (5 dc, Ch 2, 5 dc) groups. Fasten off.

8th rnd: Join appropriate color in first sc. Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. *1 sc in each of next 2 dc. 1 dc in each of next 3 dc. (2 tr. Ch 2. 2 tr) in next ch-2 sp. 1 dc in each of next 3 dc. 1 sc in each of next 2 dc.** 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * around, ending last repeat at **. Join with sl st in first sc. 30 sc, 36 dc and 6 (2 tr. Ch 2. 2 tr) groups (6 points). Fasten off.

9th rnd: Join appropriate color in any ch-2 sp. Ch 1. 3 sc in same sp as sl st. 1 sc in each st to next ch-2 sp. *3 sc in next ch-2 sp. 1 sc in each st to next ch-2 sp. Rep from * around. Join with sl st in first sc. 108 sc. Fasten off.

10th rnd: Join D with sl st in first sc of 3-sc group at tip of any point. Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. *Picot. Skip next sc. 1 sc in each of next 7 sc. Sc3tog.** 1 sc in each of next 7 sc. Rep from * to last 6 sc, ending last repeat at **. 1 sc in each of last 6 sc. Join with sl st in first sc. 90 sc and 6 picot. Fasten off D.

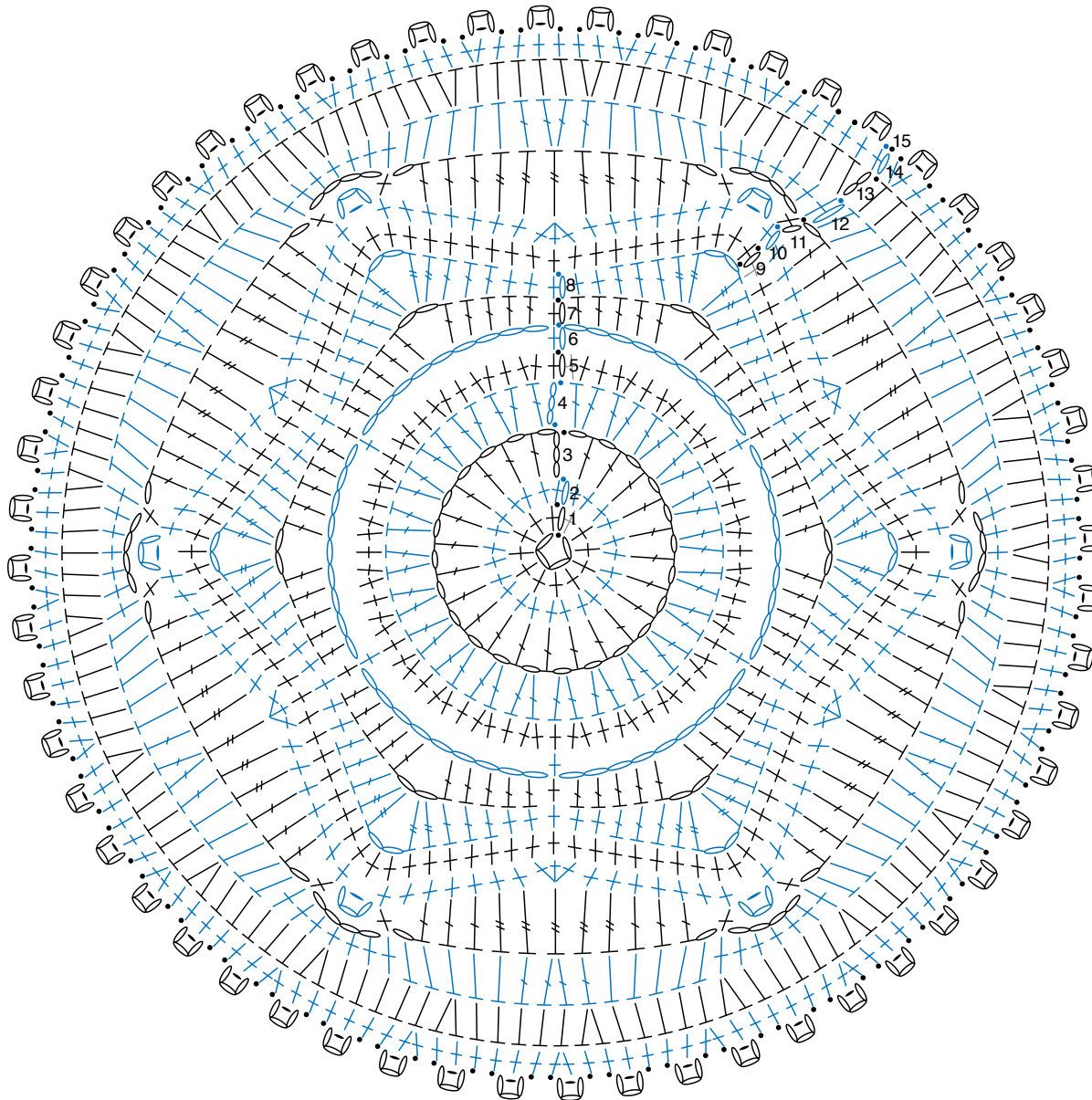
11th rnd: Join appropriate color with sl st in sc immediately before any picot. Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. *Ch 4. Skip picot. 1 sc in next sc. Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 dc in each of next 3 sc. 1 tr in each of next 5 sts. 1 dc in each of next 3 sc.** Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * to last 2 sc. Ch 1. Skip last 2 sc. Join with sl st in first sc. 78 sts, 12 ch-1 sps, and 6 ch-4 sps (2 sc. 6 dc. 5 tr and 2 ch-1 sps between ch-4 sps).

12th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st. *5 sc in next ch-4 sp. 1 sc in next sc. 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp. 1 hdc in each of next 4 sts. 1 dc in next st. 2 dc in next st. 1 dc in next st. 1 hdc in each of next 4 sts. 1 hdc in next ch-1 sp.** 1 sc in next st. Rep from * around, ending last repeat at **. Join with sl st in first sc. 126 sts (21 sts along each of 6 sides). Fasten off.

13th rnd: Join appropriate color with sl st in first sc. Ch 2 (counts as hdc). 1 hdc in same sp as sl st. 1 hdc in each of next 5 sts. *2 hdc in next st. 1 hdc in each of next 5 sts. Rep from * around. Join with sl st in top of first hdc. 147 hdc.

14th rnd: Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as sl st and each of next 5 hdc. 2 sc in next hdc. *1 sc in each of next 6 hdc. 2 sc in next hdc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st in first sc. 168 sc.

15th rnd: *Picot. Skip next sc. Sl st in each of next 2 sc. Rep from * around. 56 picots. Fasten off.



STITCH KEY

- = slip stitch (sl st)
- ⊥ = single crochet (sc)
- ⊥ = half double crochet (hdc)
