



Featuring Anchor® Embroidery Tapestry Wool
Embellish a sweater with this embroidered Mimosa design using Anchor® Tapestry Wool.

MATERIALS

Anchor® Tapestry Wool: 1 of each color

Tapestry needle, size 18 or 20. Transfer paper or stabilizer. Scissors

Sst = Satin Stitch

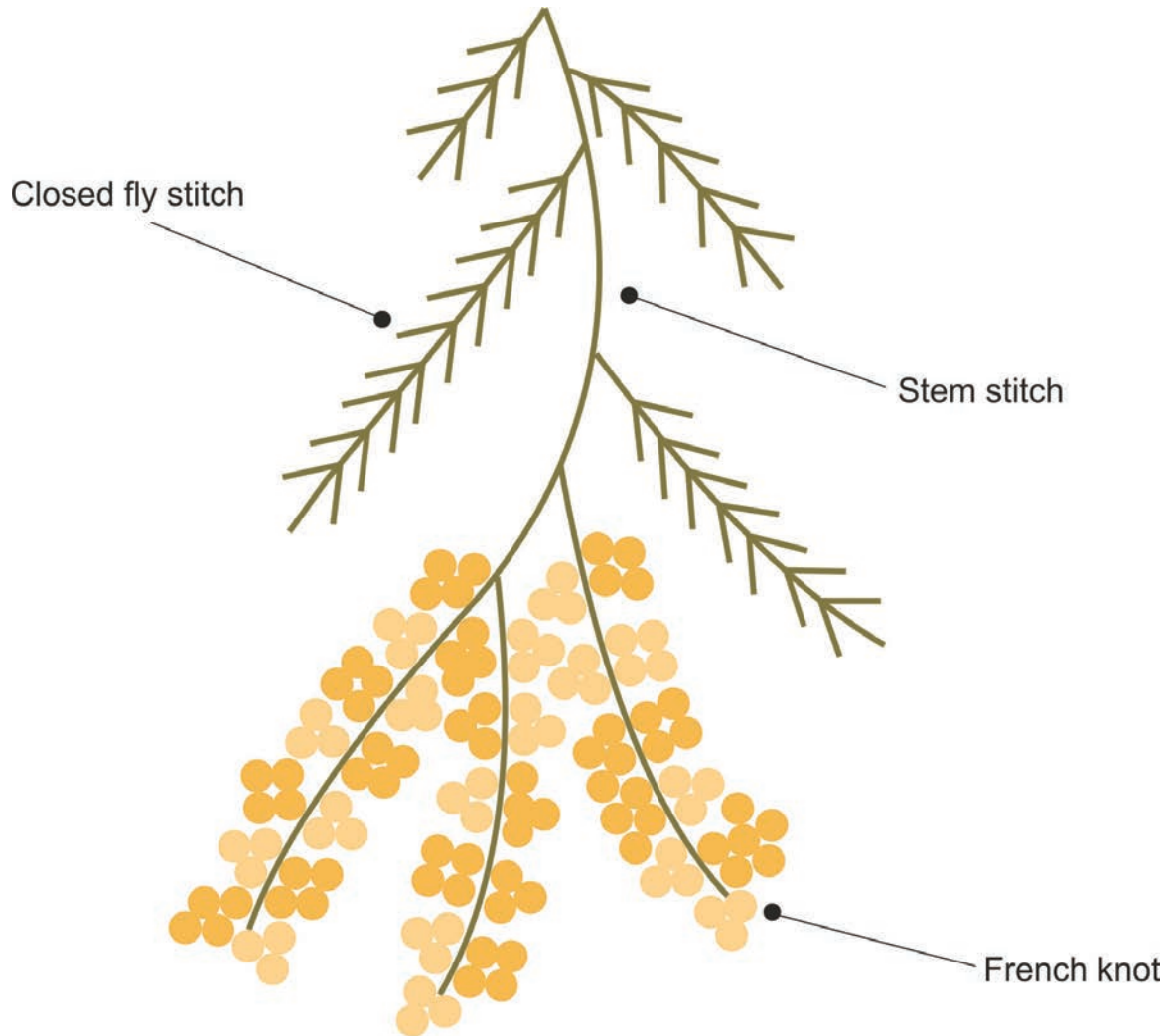
MEASUREMENT




Finished design is approximately
3" w x 5½" h (7.5cm x 14cm)

INSTRUCTIONS

1. You can apply this design on a wool sweater or any other knitted garment.
2. Print the pattern.
3. Transfer the pattern to the sweater. Place the paper or stabilizer over the design and trace the design. Pin to the fabric and stitch right through the stabilizer and the fabric, following the pattern markings. Avoid over-tightening the stitches.
4. Embroider stems with stem stitch.
5. Embroider the branches with closed fly stitch.
6. Remove the paper/stabilizer following manufacturer's instructions either by dissolving or tearing it away. Be careful not to over wet the tapestry wool if dissolving.
7. Finally, embroider flowers with french knot stitch. The French knot can be damaged when removing the paper or stabilizer, so it is preferable to remove it first then do the French knots.

Tip: Placing this type of fabric in a hoop can stretch the knitted material and misshape it, so if possible, work without a hoop.

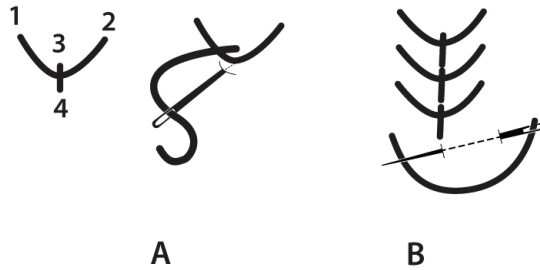
STITCHES

TIP: To separate the floss into strands, cut an 18" length. Hold one end and run the finger of your opposite hand between the strands allowing them to untwist. Thread the needle.
