### **MEASUREMENT**

Finished design is approximately 6" (15cm) in diameter.

### **INSTRUCTIONS**

**Note:** All elements use 3 strands of Anchor® Floss.

1. Transfer the design to fabric.
2. Using the stitches indicated, embroider the designs.

## Featuring Anchor® Embroidery Floss Spools

You can “build” this snowman without getting your hand cold and wet! Embroider with Anchor® Embroidery Floss on spools. Finish the hat with a little tassel.

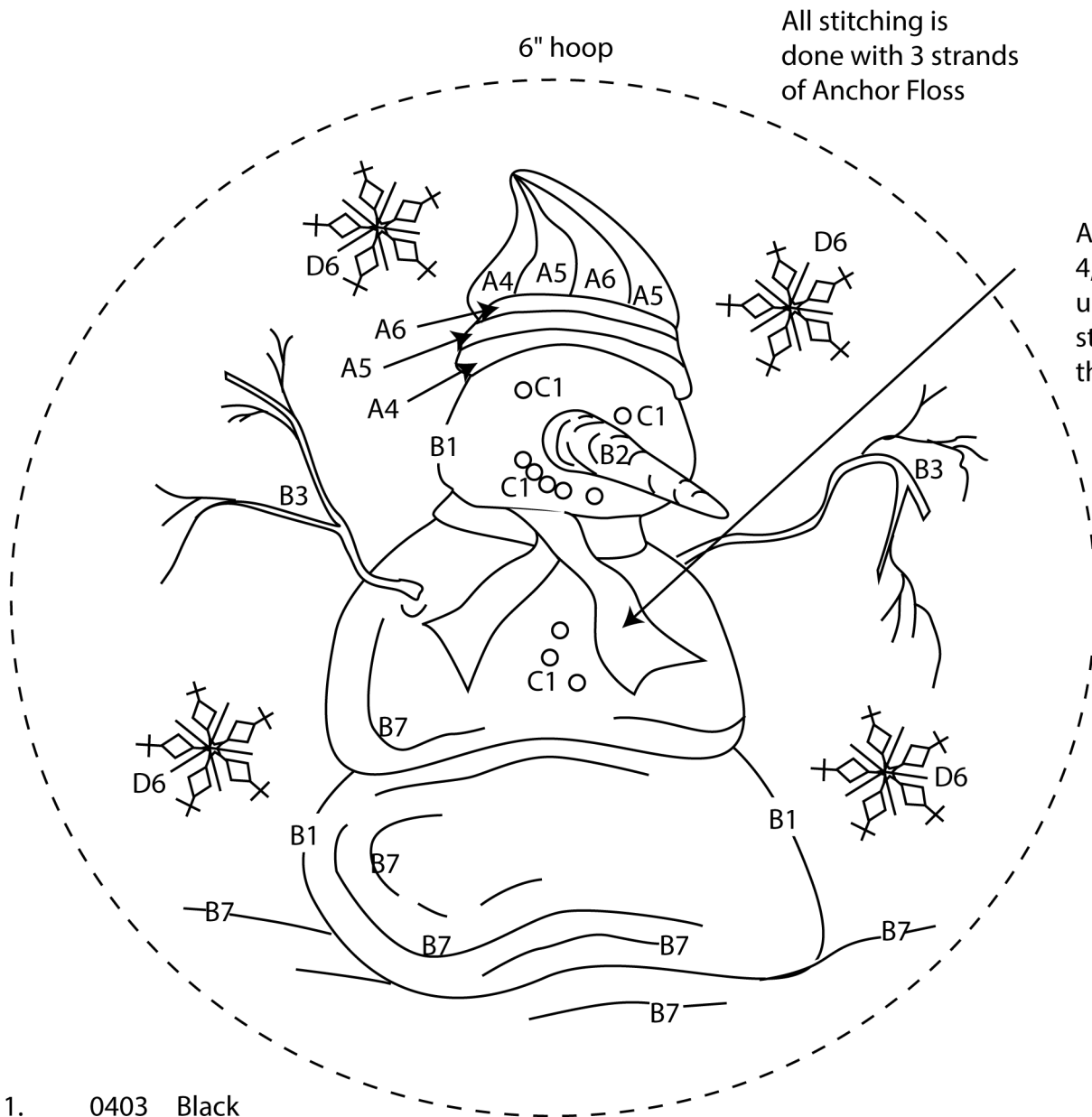
### MATERIALS

**Anchor® Embroidery Floss Spools:** 1 of each color



0403    0332    0905    1090    0147    0433    0401

Anchor® Embroidery Hoop. Embroidery or Crewel needle, size 7 or 8. Cotton fabric. Fabric marker for transferring design.




All stitching is done with 3 strands of Anchor Floss

Alternate 4, 5 and 6 using a chain stitch for the scarf

| 2. | 0332 | Blaze light             | B | Split stitch            |
| 3. | 0905 | Tawny dark              | C | French knot             |
| 4. | 1090 | Electric blue light     | D | Straight (spoke) stitch |
| 5. | 0147 | Delft blue medium light |   |                         |
| 6. | 0433 | Ice blue                |   |                         |
| 7. | 0401 | Grey dark               |   |                         |

In the diagram, the letter refers to the stitch and the number refers to the color. For example, A1 means to the Chain stitch with Anchor Floss 0403 black.

**Tassel:**  
Cut six 2" strands from colors 4, 5 and 6. Tie a strand around the middle as shown.



Fold bringing the ends together and tie a strand around the top as shown.



Trim and stitch to the top of the hat.



## STITCHES

**TIP:** To separate the floss into strands, cut an 18" length. Hold one end and run the finger of your opposite hand between the strands allowing them to untwist. Thread the needle.
