
INSTRUCTIONS

Embroider:


1. Cut out the block letters and heart given. See templates on pages 4-5.
2. Pin them centered, following the photograph of the pillow, on the 15" x 15" (38cm x 38cm) of denim.
3. Trace around them with chalk.
4. Embroider LOVE, centered on the 15" x 15" (38cm x 38cm) denim following the diagram. See diagram on page 2.

Sewing:

1. Thread the sewing machine with Coats & Clark™ all-purpose thread on top and in the bobbin.
2. Fold under a double 1" (2.5cm) hem along each of the 15" (38cm) edges of the 15" x 13" (38cm x 33cm) pieces. Press.

3. Stitch near the edge creating two hems. See diagram. 

4. Place them overlapped, to create a 15" (38cm) square.

5. Place the overlapped pieces on the pillow front right sides together and pin in place. See diagram 

6. Stitch around the pillow using a ½" (1cm) seam allowance.
7. Clip the corners, turn and press.
8. Insert the pillow form.

Featuring Anchor® Embroidery Floss on Spools

Make this eclectic "LOVE" pillow. It's fun to do with just a few stitches, and Anchor® embroidery floss colors pop on the denim fabric.

MATERIALS

Anchor® Embroidery Floss on Spools: 1 of each color



Coats & Clark™ Dual Duty XP® all-purpose thread to match denim.
1 yard (.91m) denim. 14" (36cm) pillow form. Chalk

MEASUREMENT

14" x 14" (36cm x 39cm)

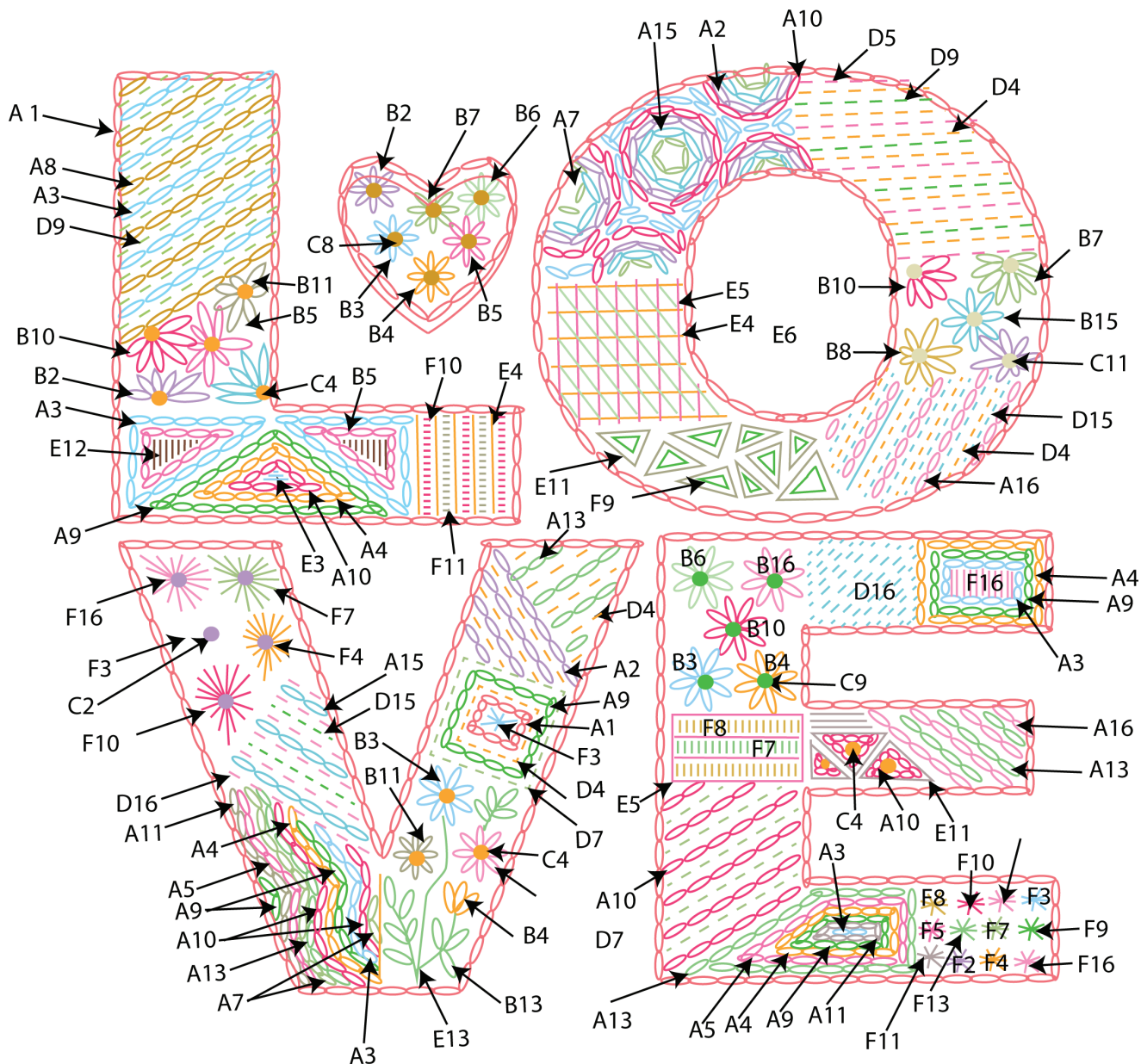
CUTTING

From pillow fabric:

- (1) square 15" x 15" (38cm x 38cm) for pillow front
- (2) rectangles 15" x 13" (38cm x 33cm) for pillow back



In the diagram, the letter refers to the stitch and the number refers to the color. For example, A1 means do the chain stitch with 57 Beauty Rose Medium. All stitching done with three strands of floss.

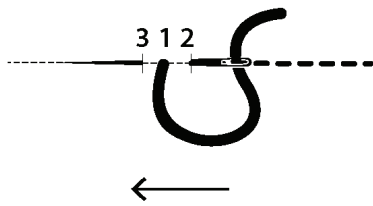

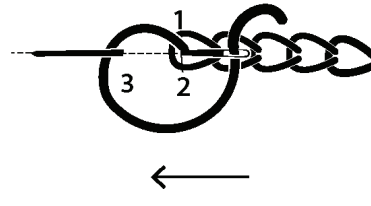
STITCHES

TIP: To separate the floss into strands, cut an 18" length. Hold one end and run the finger of your opposite hand between the strands allowing them to untwist. Thread the needle.

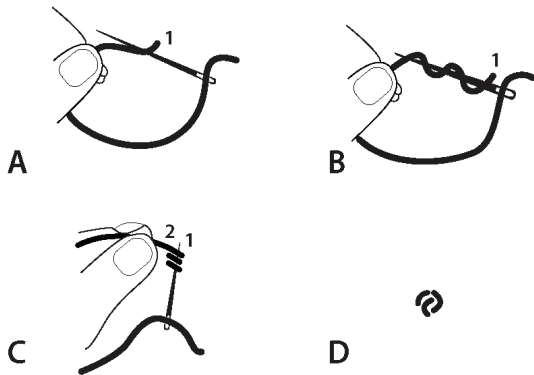
BACK STITCH



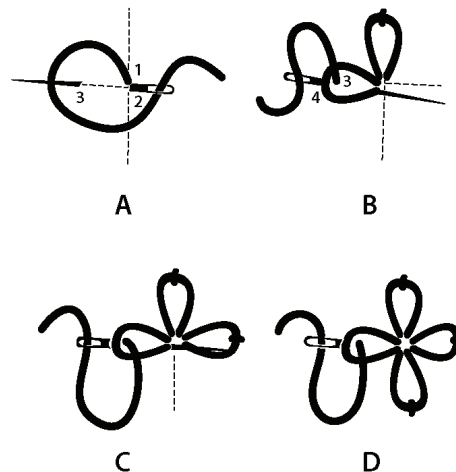
CHAIN STITCH



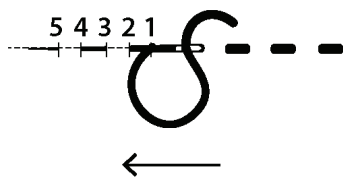
FRENCH KNOT
