Featuring Anchor® Embroidery Floss on Spools Stitch a simply beautiful felt stocking using Anchor® Embroidery Floss on spools. Cut basic shapes from felt and embellish with hand embroidery.

MATERIALS Anchor® Embroidery Floss on Spools: 1 of each color 0059 0048 0940 0942 0033 0214 1002 0031 0975 Felt

1/4 yard (.23m) of white felt for stocking and cuff backing 1/8 yard (.11m) of blue felt for ornaments and cuff 1/8 yard (.11m) or one square of peach and green felt for ornaments Ribbon

12" (30cm) of 1" (2.5cm) wide sheer ribbon Embroidery or Crewel needle, size 7 or 8 Fabric marker for transferring design

MEASUREMENT

Finished design is approximately 9"w x 13" h (23cm x 33cm)

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Cut out the stocking from white felt using the pattern provided.
- 2. Cut out the ornaments from green, peach and blue felt.
- 3. Cut out the cuff pieces and set them aside.
- 4. Transfer the designs using transfer paper or draw the designs on the felt using an air soluble marker.
- 5. Embroider the designs following the chart on page xxx.
- 6. To assemble the stocking, begin by embroidering the snowflakes on one of the blue cuff pieces.
- Mark the running stitches using a small ruler and air soluble marking pen 1/4" (.5cm) apart. This will help you to space the stitches evenly.
- 8. Place the snowflake stitched blue cuff wrong sides together with one of the white cuff pieces and stitch across the top.
- 9. Insert the stocking between the layers and stitch across the bottom of the cuff, securing the cuff to the stocking.
- 10. Repeat with the other cuff pieces and the stocking back.





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11. Finally, place the stocking pieces wrong sides together and stitch the sides and around the bottom of the stocking.



12. For the hanging ribbon, fold the ribbon in half and tack it in place.



13. Take another stitch gathering one side as shown.



14. Repeat on the other side.














In the diagram, the letter refers to the stitch and the number refers to the color. For example, A1 means to the Straight stitch with 0059 China rose.

- A. Straight (spoke) stitch
- B. Chain stitch
- C. Lazy Daisy
- D. Split stitch
- E. Running stitch






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
STITCHES

TIP: To separate the floss into strands, cut an 18" length. Hold one end and run the finger of your opposite hand between the strands allowing them to untwist. Thread the needle.





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


*** Measure templates before cutting to confirm printing at 100%***





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


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


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This square should measure 1" x 1" (2.54cm x 2.54cm) when printed.
