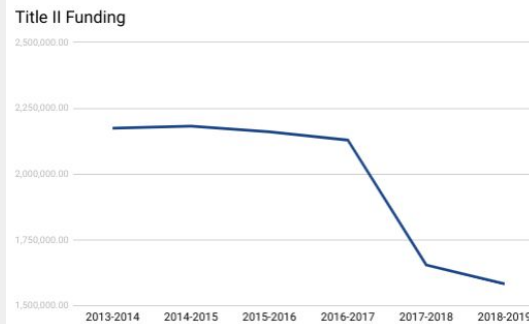

Title II, Part A Funding 2013-2019

2013: 24 coaches

2019: 18 coaches

Loss of 6 instructional coaches impacting 12 schools

Title II Funded Instructional Coaches

2011 to 2012
Elementary schools experienced a 29% decrease in mathematics SOL scores resulting in six unaccredited schools

2015
Elementary schools experienced a 30% increase in mathematics SOL scores

2012
Title II funds were used to increase the number of mathematics specialists in elementary non-Title I buildings

2017-Present
100% of schools in VBCPS fully accredited

Current Impact of Title II Funds

Title II, Part A grant funds 18 instructional coaches who work directly in schools with teachers providing mathematics and literacy expertise, coaching, professional learning, and support.

11 private schools receive funds for professional development.

Potential Impact of Losing Title II Funding

- Teachers will lose access to instructional coaches who provide job-embedded professional learning to build teacher capacity for quality instructional delivery.
- Funding will diminish for private schools' professional development opportunities.
