4. At one point Lissa observes Josef's loyalty to be fierce. Do you think Josef's loyalty helped or hindered him when sorting through all of his beliefs, both new and old? Do you think such a quality helped or hindered Lissa to ultimately trust Josef?

5. Both Lissa and Penny are exhilarated and exhausted while working as Red Cross nurses. Have you ever felt so needed that you've pushed yourself too hard?

6. What do you think motivated Josef most to return to America and face charges for what he did in the past?

7. The Influenza epidemic of 1918 took more lives worldwide than the war itself (excluding war-wounded) yet there is little emphasis on this segment of world history. Do you think the epidemic played a role in bringing the First World War to an end?
