- It publishes original source material.




The World's First Global Fourth Estate

- Launched in 2007, it published over 10 million documents with pristine record of accuracy.
- More classified information than all media combined exposing human right abuses, government spying and war crimes on a scale that was unprecedented.
- Won many prestigious journalism awards.



Invention of New Journalism




What Problems Has WikiLeaks Solved?

 Managed democracy, elite control (government secrecy)

• Restriction on free speech

 Corporate media (propaganda machine)


 Professionalization of journalists (gatekeeper)



How?

- Philosophy of Cypherpunks
 Using cryptography to ensure civil liberties
 Left vs. Right but "Institutions vs. Individuals"
- Anonymous secure online submission system
- Made free speech permissionless, borderless and censorship free






Scientific Journalism

- Just like scientific papers, where researchers are required to publish all experimental data that informed their conclusion, WikiLeaks releases all information to the public.
- Replaced journalists' creed of objectivity with actual data.
- By providing full achieves in searchable format, public can independently check interpretation of journalists



- Conceals information
- Creates 'news' to manipulate public opinion
- Controls historical narrative







- Reveals information that has been suppressed
- Restores accurate record of history and collective memory


