About the term «witch hunt»

Switzerland has been the land where most witches were executed during the witch hunts.

The phenomenom of witch hunts is very specific as it does not concern the single persecution of one person accused of witchcraft but the persecution and prosecution of many, believed to be forming a sect.

 Witches have been prosecuted legally and executed before this date

1428 : Sion

- The first documented witch hunt took place in Sion in 1428.
 Hans Fründ wrote a report about it around 1431. These took
 place on the territory of the duchy of Savoie and the
 prince-bishopric of Sion.
- To document witch hunts and find the names of the many persons persecuted we therefore need to look into the legal procedures led against them.
- These **legal procedures** are the heritage of procedures led by the Inquisition against the « heretics». They constitute a progress in the sense that they are documented and follow a procedure which was not the case before.

The wikiwitch project: properties

- First we worked on listing properties for people and for their trials
- Then we proposed a detail example for people to follow Alexander Hammiltoun and his trial

- A trial is something structured chronologically:
- 1) There is a rumor
- 2) There can be an inquiry
- 3) The witch is formally accused
- 4) Arrestation
- 5) Detention
- 6) Interrogation (and possibly torture)
- 7) Sentence
- 8) Execution of the sentence

Each of these steps can be documented by sources or not and will appear in the wikidata items

The wikiwitch project: people

Along our path we discovered that many types of actors are interesting to document in trials not just alleged witches: judges, inquisitors, witnesses notary, executors. So we added them as well

• • • •

- A person needs to have certain information
- 1) place of death
- 2) The witch is formally accused
- 3) Arrestation
- 4) Detention (and place of detention)
- 5) Interrogation (and possibly torture)
- 6) Sentence delivered
- 7) Execution of the sentence (never done by an inquisitor)

Each of these steps can be documented by sources or not and will appear in the wikidata items
