The steamship Palmetto, Captain Smith arrived this morning from Port Lavacca.

Capt. Burbank, U. S. A., who came passenger on the Palmetto, left Ban Antonio on the Edd alt, and traveled from Eagle Pass, a military post on the Rio Grande, to San Antonio.

On the 16th he passed the bodies of seven Mexicans who had been killed by the Cemanche Indians about 24 miles east of Leona and 55 anties west of San Antonio. These Mexicans who had been carrying military supplies to the Licona and were returning with their empty or carts, having been joined by another Mexican who had been riding express; he and any of the seven teamsters were killed, one teamster leacaping. The Indians were supposed to number about thirty, and from the marks of bellets on the carts were evidently supplied with fireating. The bodies of the Mexicans were stripped and everything worth-taking carried off.
