DANIEL S. CAMPBELL
COLONEL

Born 32 years ago in Hopkinsville, Kentucky, Colonel Campbell's military career began, as he says, "in the cradle." His father had determined that his son was to have a military career and his life was pointed for West Point from the time he could walk.

He was appointed to "the Point" in 1928, and while a student there was active in athletics, having his principal success in track. In his senior year he was a member of the honor committee, one of the most coveted honors of the class.

He graduated from the academy in the spring of 1932, and was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant, and immediately applied for pilot training and was accepted. His primary and basic training

was done at Randolph Field and his advanced at nearby Kelly. He won his wings in 1933 and was immediately assigned to the 19th Pursuit Squadron. His first post as a flying officer was at Wheeler Field in Hawaii, where he served until 1937. In 1935 he was promoted to a First Lieutenant, and in 1937, shortly after his return to Kelly Field as an instructor, he was made a Captain.

In 1940 he was transferred to Brooks Field, where he was promoted to the rank of Major. Then, in 1941, he went to Lubbock Army Air Field as Director of Training. While there he became a Lieutenant Colonel. In the fall of 1942 he was transferred to Pampa as Commanding Officer and then made Colonel.

HISTORY OF THE PAMPA ARMY AIR FIELD

As a monument to a dream stands the \$8,000,000 war plant that is Pampa Army Air Field. It was the vision of a group of forward-minded citizens of Pampa who made this great project become a reality.

These men of Pampa, actuated by patriotic motives, both national and civic, were determined that their city should make some real contribution to the war effort. And so it began. Just what part in the nation's defense set-up Pampa was to play, no one knew. But Pampa, they felt, was ideally endowed for such a purpose because here were located splendid natural resources such as cheap gas. It is certain that the huge \$8,000,000 training school, the unwieldy child of their dreams, far exceeded their most enthusiastic hopes.

On May 15, 1942, came the eagerly-awaited announcement from Washington that Pampa was to participate in the war program. A few days later the United States engineers arrived to take charge of the air base construction. Offices were opened immediately and actual ground breaking began.

August, September and October were especially busy months at the air base. Workers were constructing hangars, runways, barracks and office buildings. Air Force officers, non-commissioned officers, and trained enlisted men began arriving as each new building was completed. Necessary equipment and machinery was installed in some of the buildings even before the paint was dry or the shavings swept from the floors.

On November 22, Lieutenant Colonel Daniel S. Campbell, commanding officer of the new Pampa Army Air Field was disappointed in his hopes for being the first man to land on the field when a plane from Chickasha, Oklahoma, was forced down at the field just three minutes before his plane was due to arrive.

The first group of aviation cadets arrived December 1, 1942, to begin training at the new Army Air Forces Advanced Flying School. Two weeks later the sub-depot at the air base was officially opened and is manned by

personnel from the Enid, Oklahoma, air base, many of whom moved their families to Pampa.

Early in January the new athletic program planned for the benefit of the men at the base got under way with the organization of basketball teams. The early days of January also saw the opening of the post theatre, a modern and up to date play house that ran as its first picture, "You Were Never Lovlier," starring Fred Astaire and Rita Hayworth.

January 17 was the day of the arrival of the second class of aviation cadets, officially known as the class of 43-C.

Pampa's new Army Air Forces Advanced Flying School graduated its first class of cadets on February 16. Brigadier General Isaiah Davies, Commanding General of the 34th Flying Training Wing delivered the graduation address to the newly commissioned Second Lieutenants.

February 20, 1943, saw the arrival of cadets 43-D, the third group of Axis smashers sent to Pampa for their training. These men represented a total of 42 states in addition to Puerto Rico and the District of Columbia.

Open house at Pampa's new Air Forces Advanced Flying School was held on Sunday, March 7. At that time the public was given the opportunity to see the field in operation. Thousands of civilians from Pampa and surrounding communities were ushered over the grounds. But even though it was open house to the public, "business as usual" was the program of the day for the flying cadets and their instructors. Civilians enjoyed the rare opportunity of being allowed to see the men at their work.

Thus a dream, a "multi-million dollar dream" became reality at Pampa, Texas. To those few men of vision who first saw the field as a possibility goes much of the credit for its final construction. And to those aviation cadets who have finished their training and have gone from the field to complete their mission over the battle fields of the world, to them will go much of the credit for the ultimate victory of the allied nations.

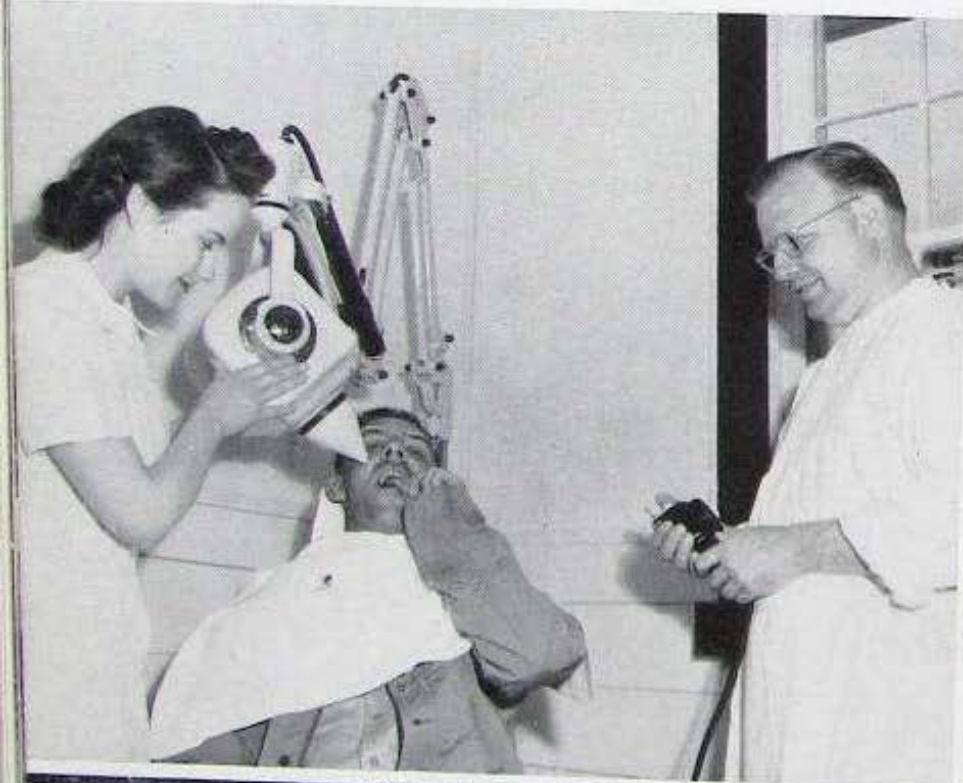

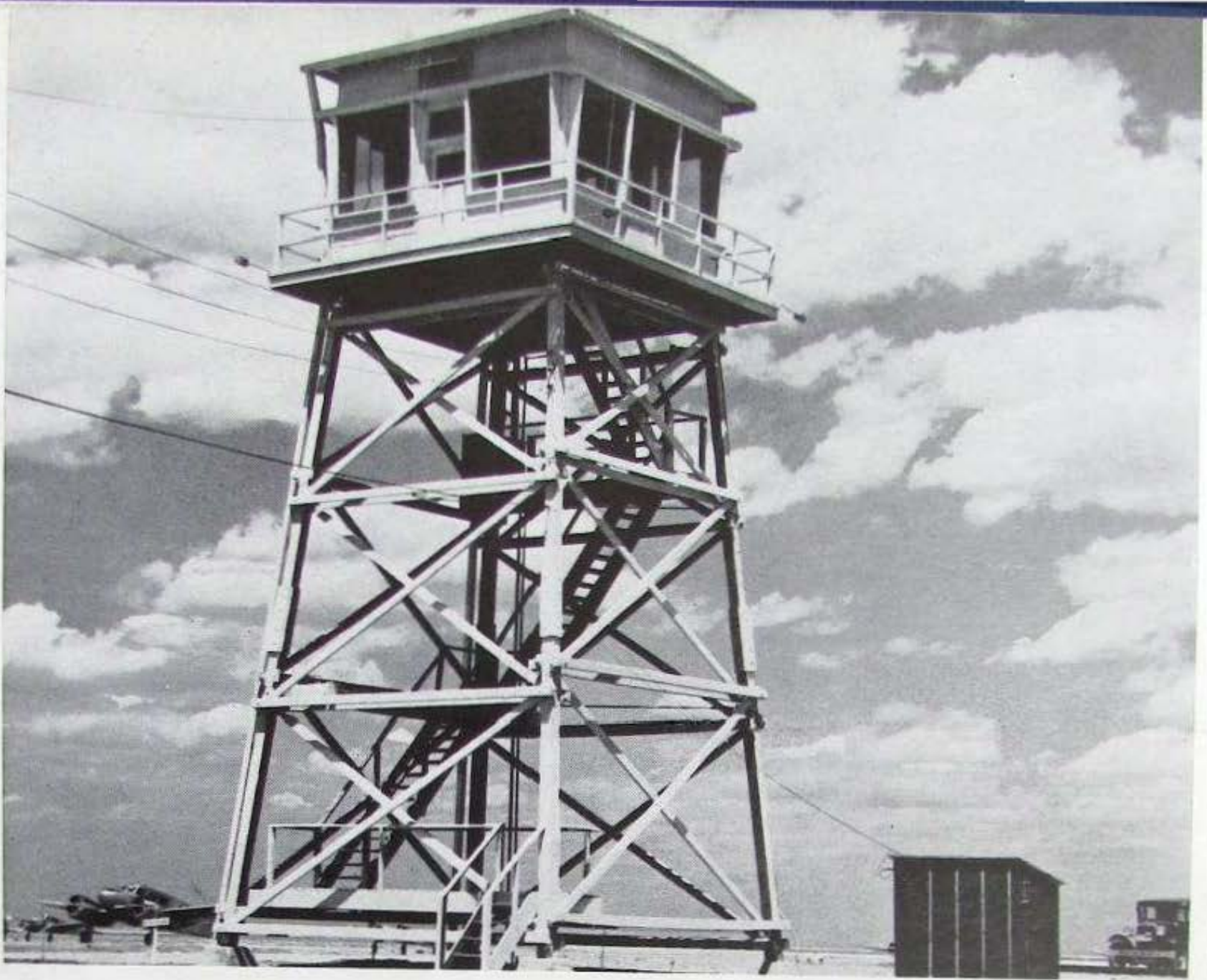

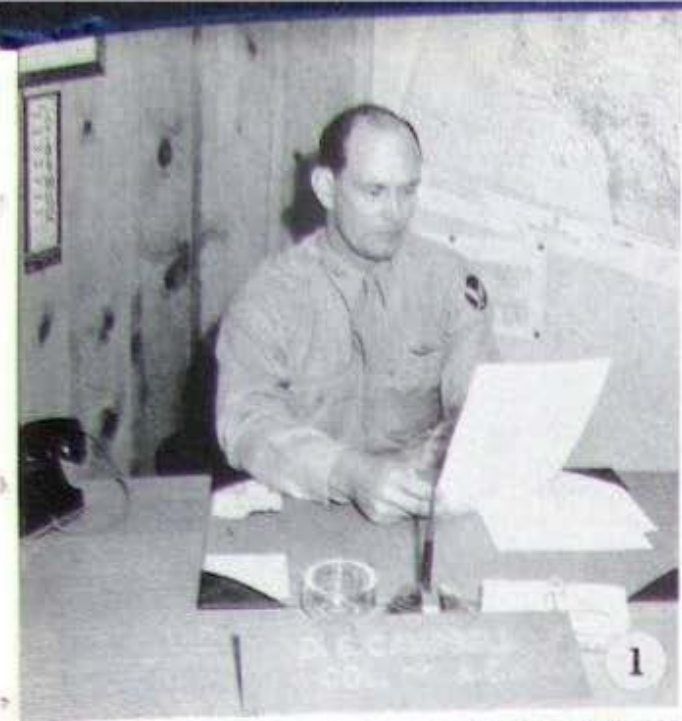
